

### **i-DREAMS FINAL EVENT**

On Wednesday 26 April 2023, we organised our closing event in Brussels to present the project results and achievements. A group of about 60 people attended the event consisting of consortium partners, members from the expert and user advisory boards, participants of the field trials (both individual car drivers as well as company representatives) and several other interested organisations.

Before noon we focused on the building blocks of the i-DREAMS technology followed by a panel discussion among field trial participants, representatives from the insurance sector, fleet management, public transport and training centres for professional drivers. They all saw the clear added value of the i-DREAMS system, since it provides an integrated prevention platform for the fleet manager and allows scalable and at the same time individual guidance of professional drivers

In the afternoon the key results of the i-DREAMS project were highlighted. In a concluding panel discussion, experts identified the potential but also the challenges for operating i-DREAMS in the future.

**Prof. dr. Tom Brijs (i-DREAMS coordinator):** "Thanks to i-DREAMS technology, we see a significant decrease in the number of risky situations while driving among car drivers. Among professional drivers (truck, bus), we see mixed results that depend on the way the technology in the organisation, is part of an integral safety culture."





### **i-DREAMS FINAL BROCHURE**

Through 37 deliverables we described our research journey. These technical reports, most of which available on our website, are often difficult to read for a non-scientific audience. Therefore our communication manager interviewed the authors of the different deliverables to let them tell their research story in a non-scientific way. All these interviews were compiled in this brochure, together with a couple of short syntheses of the deliverables that are confidential, thus not publicly available on our website.
